## High roller wagered on Fair Grounds race after start



Mike Maloney, a Keeneland Race Course-based high roller who bets between \$6-million and \$12-million per year and as much as \$10,000 on a single race, said Thursday at the Symposium on Racing and Gaming that on November 25 he bet

on the third race at Fair Grounds after the race started.

The opportunity was brought to Maloney's attention when the race started, but he did not hear a beep from the mutuel machine indicating the race had been locked for wagering. Through a live teller, Maloney said he then made four wagers that were similar to bets he already had made on the race. He said they were all losing tickets.

Jim Williams, director of communications for Keeneland, confirmed that Maloney was able to wager on the Fair Grounds race after the start. He said that Keeneland investigated the situation and that the teller confirmed making the wagers for Maloney knowing that the race had already started.

Lenny Vangilder, a spokesman for Fair Grounds, confirmed that wagering was not stopped when the race began. He said that the stop-wagering mechanism the stewards use malfunctioned and that the mutuel manager stopped wagering 15 seconds after the race began.

Maloney said that he wagered well after that, adding that he was placing wagers at least a half-mile into the 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ -mile race that 7-to-5 favorite Nakayama Kun won by 11 $\frac{1}{2}$  lengths after racing off the pace. Typically, past posting—wagering after the time when bets are no longer allowed—is said to benefit those who bet on front-runners, but Good Offer at 4.20-to-1 faded to fifth in the six-horse field after going the opening half-mile in :47.85.

Vangilder said that the stop-wagering function worked on the next

race and that Fair Grounds has not had any problems since. He did not know how much handle the race generated after the start.

The Symposium held several discussions involving wagering integrity and improving technology, two issues at the heart of past posting—long seen as an issue in racing with suspicious odds changes long into the running of a race often the norm.

"What would happen if this happened at keno," Maloney said. "If someone could play a keno ticket after two balls were drawn, the gaming commission would close all the games until the casinos improved technology," Maloney said.

"The [racing] industry doesn't address this because it costs money and doesn't make money, but it hurts the pool and hurts the game. They don't care because they get their commission whether people win or lose."

For Fair Grounds part, Vangilder emphasized that it was a one-time technical error rather than a breach of security.—*Ed DeRosa*

## True Metropolitan, Palladio among finalists for 2007 Sovereign Awards

Canadian Grade 3 winners True Metropolitan and Palladio and stakes winner Stonetown are finalists in the champion older male on the main track category for the 2007 Sovereign Awards, Canada's equivalent of the Eclipse Awards.

The 33rd annual Sovereign Awards ceremony will be held on De-

cember 14 at Westin Harbour Castle in Toronto.

True Metropolitan earned a Sovereign Award as Canada's champion older male in '06. The Proud and True gelding has won seven of his ten starts this season, including wins at Woodbine in the Autumn Stakes (Can-G3) on November 17 and the Dominion Day Stakes (Can-G3) on July 1.

Palladio was Canada's champion three-year-old male of 2005. Trained by Roger Attfield for owner-breeder Haras Santa Maria de Araras, the Lycius horse won the Eclipse Stakes (Can-G3) on May 21 at Woodbine.

Stonetown earned his first career stakes win in the Elgin Stakes on September 3 at Woodbine. A career earner of \$214,389 who has won five of his nine starts, Stonetown is trained by Abraham Katryan for Spring Farm and Racing Canada Inc.

Financingavailable, Canada's '06 champion older mare, is a Sovereign Award finalist in three categories—champion older female on the main track, champion turf female, and champion sprinter. The Kiri-dashi mare has earned five wins in seven starts this season, including consecutive victories on Woodbine's main track in the Classy 'n Smart Stakes on October 8 and the Ontario Fashion Stakes on November 3.

Financingavailable also won the Victoriana Stakes, a 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ -mile turf race on August 19 at Woodbine.

**Horsemen's groups form company to focus on simulcasting issues**

Representatives of eight Thoroughbred horsemen's associations have joined together to create the Thoroughbred Horsemen's Group, a limited liability company organized to promote individual and collaborative interstate simulcasting activities.

"The Thoroughbred Horsemen's Group is the logical next step for horsemen's organizations dealing with simulcast issues in a multi-jurisdictional business environment with multitrack consortiums and integrated companies like TrackNet Media," said racehorse owner Bob Reeves, the newly elected president of the Thoroughbred Horsemen's Group.

Reeves also serves as a director of the Ohio Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association and co-chairman of the National HBPA's Wagering and Alternative Gaming Committee.

"We believe that our company will create efficiencies in simulcasting administration and implementation; enhance the effectiveness of horsemen's organizations as representatives of the industry's most important stakeholder, the racehorse owner; and in the long-term help improve the competitiveness and productivity of the Thoroughbred racing industry.

"Our game faces new challenges, the simulcasting model is out-

dated, and we are confident that the Thoroughbred Horsemen's Group can be a constructive instrument for horsemen to address those challenges and contribute to their solutions."

Enrolling as members of the Thoroughbred Horsemen's Group are HBPA organizations from Virginia, Kentucky, Florida, Pennsylvania, and Louisiana as well as the Delaware Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association and the Texas Horsemen's Partnership.

Named as officers of the company in addition to Reeves are Pennsylvania HBPA President Joe Santanna, treasurer; Virginia HBPA Executive Director Frank Petramalo, secretary and general counsel.

## Marvelous Manduro

According to the international committee that compiles the official International Classification, the best racehorse in the world in 2007 was Manduro. The committee's most recent version of the World Thoroughbred Rankings placed the German-bred five-year-old at 130 pounds, two pounds clear of Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe Lucien Barriere (Fr-G1) winner Dylan Thomas (Ire), Vodafone Epsom Derby (Eng-G1) winner Authorized, and Breeders' Cup Classic Powered by Dodge (G1) winner Curlin.

### MANDURO

Unbeaten in five starts this year, Manduro beat Dylan Thomas by 1¼ lengths in the Prince of Wales's Stakes (G1) over 1¼ miles at Royal Ascot in June, slammed specialist milers in the 1,600-meter (7.95-furlong) Prix du Haras de Fresnay-le-Buffard Jacques le Marois (Fr-G1), and contemptuously dismissed 2006 French champion filly Mandesha by 2½ lengths in the Prix Foy Gray d'Albion Barriere (Fr-G2) over 2,400 meters (11.93 furlongs) in his final start.

By the great German sire Monsun out of Mandellicht, by Be My Guest, Manduro was bred in Germany by Rolf Brunner, but Monsun's owner, Baron Georg von Ullmann, purchased him for 130,000 euros (\$114,400) at the 2003 BBAG August yearling sale in Baden-Baden. An unbeaten champion two-year-old male in Germany, Manduro did not race until September of his three-year-old season because of injury. He extended his unbeaten streak to four before running a below-form fourth in the Premio Roma (Ity-G1).

Transferred to perennial French champion trainer Andre Fabre for his four-year-old season, he won the 2006 Prix d'Harcourt (Fr-G2) easily but then suffered a series of misfortunes, finishing second or third

in his remaining seven races that year. Ridden in 2007 by Stephane Pasquier, he never looked beatable at any stage of his five races. He was injured in his final start and thus missed the Arc.

His sire, Monsun, won three Group 1s in Germany and will lead the German sire list for the fifth time this year. To date, Monsun has sired 65 stakes winners from only 398 foals of racing age, a sparkling 16.3% strike rate. His top runners include highweights Shirocco (Ger), winner of the 2005 John Deere Breeders' Cup Turf (G1); Gentlewave; Schiaparelli; Samum; Salve Regina; and Le Miracle.

Monsun is a sixth-generation male-line descendant of Blandford, the dominant classic sire of the 1930s in England and Ireland. Blandford's best son, unbeaten English Triple Crown winner \*Bahram, sired top stayer and outstanding sire Persian Gulf. In turn, Persian Gulf's most precocious son, the good 1954 English two-year-old Tamerlane, sired three-time German champion and two-time leading German sire Dschingis Khan. The latter's German Horse of the Year son and three-time leading German sire, Königsstuhl, is Monsun's sire.

Manduro is inbred 3x4 to Dschingis Khan, and his extended pedigree is replete with German names that are unfamiliar to American readers. His six-cross pedigree also carries multiple crosses of important German sires Olymp, Ticino, and Masetto, as well as Nearco and Hyperion, for an inbreeding coefficient of 2.16%.

Manduro's half sister by Acatenango, Mandela (Ger), won a stakes in Germany in 2003, ran third in the '04 Santa Barbara Handicap (G2), and sold for \$1.4-million at the recent Keeneland November breeding stock sale. Manduro's dam, Mandellicht, placed in stakes, and her winning half sister Mandamou, by Ela-Mana-Mou, produced stakes winner Mandahush, by Alwuhush, as well as a Monsun colt sold to Demi O'Byrne for 450,000 guineas (\$694,000) at the Tattersalls December sale on November 30.

Manduro's fourth dam, Mariapolis, by Acropolis, was imported to Germany in the 1960s. His third dam, Mandriale, by Norfolk, produced 1990 Mehl-Muelhens Rennen (Ger-G2) (German Two Thousand Guineas) winner Mandelbaum, by Königsstuhl.

Purchased last summer by Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum, Manduro will stand the 2008 season at Kildangan Stud for 40,000 euros (\$58,750).

Manduro is an outstanding physical specimen and, even with his cross of Northern Dancer, is the best outcross to come along in many years.

# Three aim for repeat wins on Louisiana Champions Day

Charles Castille Jr.'s Costa Rising, who scored a narrow victory in the 2006 Louisiana Champions Day Classic Stakes, will aim for a repeat victory in the \$150,000 race, the headliner of the 17th renewal of Louisiana Champions Day, on Saturday at Fair Grounds.

The 11-race card includes six other Thoroughbred stakes, all worth \$100,000, for Louisiana-breds.

Costa Rising, who is tabbed as the 9-to-5 morning-line favorite, has won four of six starts this year, including three stakes. He enters the 1½-mile Classic off a 2¼-length triumph in the Gold Cup Stakes on November 17 at Delta Downs.

The four-year-old Royal Strand (Ire) colt, trained by Glenn Delahoussaye, won eight of 13 starts last year and capped the season with a head victory over Mean Butterbean in the Classic.

Costa Rising began 2007 with a 5¼-length victory in the Louisiana Premier Night Championship Stakes in February at the Vinton, Louisiana, track. He rebounded from a third-place finish to Classic challenger Grand Minit in the Pola Benoit Memorial Stakes at Evangeline with a sparkling 12¼-length romp in the Evangeline Mile Handicap on August 11, lowering the one-mile track record to 1:36.51 in the process.

Kerwin Clark piloted Costa Rising in his previous five starts. He will be ridden by Robby Albarado on Saturday.

Karla Balensiefen's Tortuga Straits, who was undefeated in five starts last year as a two-year-old, won the Louisiana Premier Night Prince Stakes in his season debut in February for his only win in three starts this year. The three-year-old Gold Tribute colt went to the sidelines for seven months after Premier Night, before returning with a fourth-place finish in the A. L. (Red) Erwin Stakes at Louisiana Downs on September 1. He enters the Classic off a nose defeat in a seven-furlong allowance race at Delta on October 27.

Also seeking repeat wins on Louisiana Champions Day are Wachtel Stable's, Brous Stable's and Jerry Lee's Desert Wheat in the Louisiana Champions Day Turf Stakes at about 1½ miles, and Stanley Seelig's Carl's Frosty Girl in the Louisiana Champions Day Ladies Sprint Stakes at six furlongs.

"The race card set for Louisiana Champions Day is one of the best in the state," said Warren Harang, president of the board of directors for the Louisiana Thoroughbred Breeders Association. "Louisiana-born and -bred Thoroughbreds have been garnering national attention and Louisiana Champions Day is the perfect showcase for our own."—Myra Lewyn

## Trainer of the Week® Maximo Gomez

Maximo Gomez may not be a familiar name to fans in the United States, but the Puerto Rican-based trainer was numero uno as North America's leading trainer by earnings for the week ended Wednesday.

Gomez, named Puerto Rico's leading trainer in 2005 and '06, saddled four winners for the week, topped by Soy Conquistador, a 5 1/2-length winner of the \$290,000 Clasico del Caribe (Caribbean Derby) at Hipodromo Camarero.

The three-year-old Sweetsouthern saint gelding, owned by Estabro Edelsam Delgado, had been a solid performer for Gomez until he was sidelined after finishing fifth in a stakes on May 28 at Hipodromo Camarero.

"This horse was suffering from ulcers during the summer, and we decided to rest him," Gomez said.

The bay gelding returned to action on October 21, finishing second by a neck in the Clasico Antonio Fernandez Castrillon prior to his smashing victory in the Clasico del Caribe.

"We gave him enough time to heal and, for this being just his second race back after the layoff, it has even surprised us how well he raced," Gomez said. "I firmly believe he is going to get even better."

Kipling, the sire of NetJets Breeders' Cup Mile (G1) winner Kip Deville, will move from Oklahoma to Pope McLean Sr.'s Crestwood Farm in Lexington for the 2008 season.

A full brother to Remsen Stakes (G2) winner Court Vision, the 11-year-old Gulch horse out of Weekend Storm, by Storm Bird, will stand for \$7,500.

Kipling, Oklahoma's leading sire with \$2,387,106 in progeny earnings in 2007, covered 70 mares this spring at an advertised fee of \$2,500 at owner Warren Center's Mighty Acres in Pryor, Oklahoma.

Center said he would retain a 50% interest in Kipling. Crestwood and Three Chimneys Farm in Midway, Kentucky, both will own 25% interests.

From 51 starters in four crops of racing age, Kipling has sired five stakes winners. Kip Deville won the 2007 Maker's Mark Mile Stakes (G2) and Frank E. Kilroe Mile Handicap (G1) prior to his Breeders' Cup victory. Chad Schumer, Center's bloodstock agent, bought Kip Deville's dam, the Encino mare Klondike Kaytie, for \$6,000 in 2001.

Kipling also is the sire of five-time stakes winner Dreamvisions.—Jeff Lowe

**YOUR FLAME IN ME**

#### Remington Park

The Oklahoma City track concluded its 69-day live meeting on December 1 with **double-digit increases in attendance and simulcasting mutuel handle** compared with last year's meet, which was run over 68 days.

Total on-track attendance was 402,109, a 23% increase compared with 2006. The daily average attendance of 5,828 increased 21.2% compared with last year.

"The big gains in attendance were largely in group sales," said Scott Wells, Remington's vice president and general manager. "We hope that many of those new people will evolve into horseplayers as we help them learn more about playing the game. It all begins with the live racing experience."

Remington has now posted attendance increases for four consecutive seasons.

Total wagering on simulcasting during live racing dates was \$6,357,539, an 18.2% increase compared with the previous season. Daily average simulcast wagering on live racing dates was \$92,138, a 16.5% increase compared with last year.

Total on-track wagering was \$5,407,587, a 1.3% increase compared with '06. The average daily on-track mutuel handle on live racing was \$78,370, a figure that is comparable with last year.

Total on-track wagering was \$11,765,126, a 9.8% increase compared with '06.

# Tattersalls concludes record-setting December mare sale

Propelled by global demand for high-quality mares, the Tattersalls December mare sale concluded on Thursday with benchmarks in total receipts and average price.

Tattersalls reported 762 horses from 1,132 offered as sold for \$150,402,703 (69,498,500 guineas), a 4.9% increase from last year's record-breaking sale, when 870 horses were sold.

Average price was a record \$197,376 (91,205 guineas), up 19.8% from 2006. Median price was \$49,774 (23,000 guineas), down 23.3% from last year.

John Ferguson, bloodstock adviser for Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum, went to a European record of \$7,339,920 (3.4-million guineas) for French Group 1 winner Satwa Queen (Fr), the sale's highest price.

The five-year-old chestnut Muhtathir (GB) mare won six of 16 career starts, including the 2007 Prix de l'Opera Casino Barriere d'Enghien les Bains (Fr-G1), and earned \$776,721 in four seasons.

Consigned by Ecurie Jean de Roualle, Satwa Queen is a half sister to Group 1 winner Spadoun and is one of four stakes winners out of the Irish River (Fr) mare Tolga.

Satwa Queen was one of five mares or fillies to sell for three-million guineas or more during the four-day sale. Others were Ocean Silk, a Group 1-placed stakes winner by Dynaformer in foal to Pivotal, who was bought from the Swettenham Stud dispersal, and Group 2 winner Sander Camillo, who each sold for \$6,908,160 (3.2-million guineas);

and Mandellicht, carrying a full sibling to Group 1 winner Manduro, and multiple Grade 1 winner Angara (GB), in foal to Montjeu (Ire), who were both purchased for \$6,476,400 (3-million guineas).

Overall, ten fillies and mares fetched one-million guineas or more.

Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahoney said those statistics might not be bettered for many years to come.

## AROUND THE WORLD

### Dubai

Japanese Group 1 winners **Vermilion** (El Condor Pasa) and **Daiwa Scarlet** (Agnes Tachyon), two of Japan's most prominent racing stars, are being targeted for the **2008 Dubai World Cup (UAE-G1)** meeting.

Sunday Racing Co. Ltd.'s Vermilion, who won the Japan Cup Dirt (Jpn-G1) on November 24 at Tokyo racecourse, is being aimed for the \$6-million Emirates Airline Dubai World Cup (UAE-G1). In last year's edition of the race, he finished fourth to Invador (Arg) (Candy Stripes).

"He showed a very strong performance in the Japan Cup Dirt," said Katsumi Yoshida, of breeder Northern Farm. "The winning time was brilliant and he deserves to run in one of the world's premier races, the Dubai World Cup."

Japan's top three-year-old filly Daiwa Scarlet, who won the Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup (Jpn-G1) on November 11 at Kyoto Racecourse, is being pointed for the \$5-million Dubai Duty Free (UAE-G1).

"We are still making a plan for the filly, but as many racegoers are looking forward to seeing the battle between Daiwa Scarlet and her [half] brother [Daiwa Major (Sunday Silence)] in the Grand Prix Arima Kinen (G1) in December—it may well happen," owner-breeder Teruya Yoshida said.

"But her first run up next season will be in Dubai for the Dubai Duty Free."

### England

Prominent trainer **Harry Thomson (Tom) Jones** died on Wednesday morning. He was 82.

Jones, who became one of few trainers to be successful with runners over the jumps and on the flat, is best known for training steeple-chaser Tingle Creek (Goose Creek).

Jones trained several prominent flat runners, including Athens Wood (\*Celtic Ash), who won the 1971 St. Leger, and Touching Wood (Roberto), who annexed the '82 St. Leger (Eng-G1), the first classic winner owned by the Maktoum family.

From 1984-'94, of 34 group winners trained by Jones, 26 were owned by Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum, including '85 Goffs Irish One Thousand Guineas (Ire-G1) winner Al Bahathri (Blushing Groom [Fr]). Al Bahathri also won the '84 Lowther Stakes (Eng-G1) and '85 Coronation Stakes (Eng-G2).

Devon Ditty (GB) (Song), England's champion two-year-old filly of 1978, was also trained by Jones.

Jones was known for sparking the careers of future trainers, including champion trainer Sir Michael Stoute, *Racing Post* reported. Two of his three children—Tim Thomson Jones and Di Haine—became trainers.

Funeral arrangements have not been announced.

# Hong Kong Vase, Sprint focus of this year's International Races

The Cathay Pacific Hong Kong Cup (HK-G1) usually dominates discussion of the four Hong Kong International Races, which are set for Sunday at Sha Tin Racecourse.

Despite the presence of multiple Group 1 winner Ramonti and Nakheel Dubai Sheema Classic (UAE-G1) winner Vengeance of Rain in the seven-horse field, attention has turned European Horse of the Year Dylan Thomas (Ire) as the star of the Hong Kong Vase (HK-G1), and the exciting matchup of Australia's Horse of the Year Miss Andretti, the consistent Benbaun, and last year's Hong Kong Sprint (HK-G1) winner Absolute Champion in the Sprint.

The 2,000-meter (9.94-furlong) Hong Kong Cup is the crowning glory of the International Races, but this year the race has only the French filly Musical Way to compete against a field of Asians from Hong Kong, Japan, and the United Arab Emirates.

The 2,400-meter (11.93-furlong) Hong Kong Vase (HK-G1) became the target for Dylan Thomas after he was denied access to Japan for the Japan Cup (Jpn-G1) when his vaccination for equine viral arteritis (EVA) caused a positive test result for the disease, despite officials from the Japan Racing Association admitting they knew he did not have EVA. Dylan Thomas takes on John Deere Breeders' Cup Turf (G1) winner Red Rocks (Ire) and Man o' War Stakes (G1) winner Doctor Dino (Fr) in the Vase.

The Sprint pits the speediest horses from Singapore, Australia, France, Hong Kong, England, and Ireland over 1,200 meters (5.97 furlongs) in what could be the most competitive of the four races.

Also on the card, Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (Fr-G1) (French One Thousand Guineas) winner Darjina will take on Coolmore's Excellent Art (GB) and Godolphin's Creachadoir in the Hong Kong Mile (HK-G1).

The draw, conducted at Sha Tin Racecourse in the walking ring, was highlighted by a captivating animation of each horse exiting the sponsor Cathay Pacific's airplane onto a red carpet during the selection process. As the post positions were revealed, the animated whinnying horses would move into their respective gate stalls.

The animation was a concept of Bill Nader, the Hong Kong Jockey Club's executive director-racing, who upgraded it from previous years when the jumbo screen showed a depiction of the track and where the start and finish of each race would be during the selection.—*K. T. Donovan*
